Richard D. Amber, longtime resident of Mount Holly, went to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, Thursday, March 21, 2024. He was 98.

Dick was a 1943 graduate of Woodrow Wilson High School, Camden, and a WWII Navy Veteran. He graduated from Philadelphia School of the Bible and spent most of his life pastoring churches while employed as a mechanical engineer. He was co-director of the Christian Servicemen's Center in Wrightstown, NJ, for many years. For the last forty years until his passing, he pastored Jobstown Community Bible Church. His life-long dream was to preach the Gospel until he died, which he did.

The son of George and Myrtle Amber, Dick is pre-deceased by his wife, Ruth E. Amber, his brother, Edward, and his son-in-law, Jerry Pfaff.
