



Richard "Dick" E. Phillips Jr.

December 30, 1937 - January 1, 2017

Richard "Dick" E. Phillips, Jr. of Browns Mills, passed away on Sunday, January 1, 2017 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly, surrounded by his family. He was 79.

Born in Mount Holly, Dick was a longtime area resident and a 1957 graduate of Pemberton Township High School. He served in the US Navy and after his honorable discharge, worked as a truck driver.

Mr. Phillips, in his early years, was a volunteer fire fighter for Vincentown Fire Department. He volunteered as a Little League Coach in Pemberton for 16 years and was a Boy Scout Leader for 18 years. He was a founding member of the Pemberton Boro Hunting Club and loved deer hunting with his family. He was an avid Nascar and Dale, Jr. fan.

He is survived by his loving wife of 56 years, Patricia Phillips (McGuigan); a daughter, Denise Graham of Browns Mills; 4 sons: Richard Phillips (Becky) of Southampton, Michael Phillips (Michelle) of Pemberton Boro, Brian Phillips of FL & Steven Phillips (Krissy) of Pemberton; 18 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren. The brother of the late Jean Frake, he is survived by his brothers, William Phillips of Southampton and John Phillips of New York and his brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Bob and Jane Cline of Trenton.

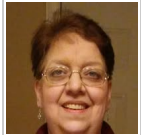
