Richard D. Larson of Cadbury in Cherry Hill, passed away on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. He was 78.

Born in Appleton, Wisconsin, the son of the late Robert J. Larson and Louise Ruth Larson, Richard joined the US Army after graduating from High School and he served his country in Vietnam. He received many awards for his service, including a Bronze Star. After his discharge from the Army, he resided in Wrightstown, where he met and married his wife Patricia. She passed away in 2013. For many years, Richard was a taxi driver for United Cab in Wrightstown. After Patricia's death, he lived for several years with his daughter, Annette until moving to Cadbury a few years ago.

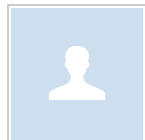
