Richard A. Powell, of Mount Holly, passed away on Monday, September 16, 2019. He was 82.

Born in Mount Holly, he was the son of the late Charles Powell and Nancy (Izzi) Heagy.

Richard graduated from Rancocas Valley Regional High School in 1952. After graduation, he joined the U.S. Navy from 1956-1961. He moved back to Mount Holly where he remained a lifelong resident.

He retired from the Burlington County Highway Department after 20+ years. He was one of the original founders of the RV Patriots Pop Warner Football Program. He was active in Mount Holly Little League for 30 plus years from the 60s, 70s, and 80s. He was an avid fan of RV sports. He enjoyed being outdoors especially hunting, searching for antique milk bottles, and golfing. He is survived by his children; Allyson Swanson, Christine Brown, Stephanie Ronaldson, Scott Hubbard, Leighann Peter, and Robert Wright; 13 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren.
