Richard Schmied, 59, passed away suddenly at his home in Southampton, NJ on December 24, 2021.

Born in Philadelphia, his parents Robert and Elizabeth bought a home in Hainesport, NJ in 1967, where he lived for most of his life. A Rancocas Valley Regional High School graduate of '80, Richard worked at IEH Auto Parts in Moorestown, NJ where he looked forward to joking with his friends at work just as he was the joker at home.
