Richard H. Wells, Richie, “the Jersey Hog”, formerly of Medford Lakes, Chatsworth and Haines City, Florida, passed away on Friday, January 23, 2026. He was 84.

Born in Mount Holly, son of the late Joseph and Mabel Wells, Richie was a Navy Veteran. He was a Master Plumber and Master Pipe Fitter with Union Local #322 in Winslow. 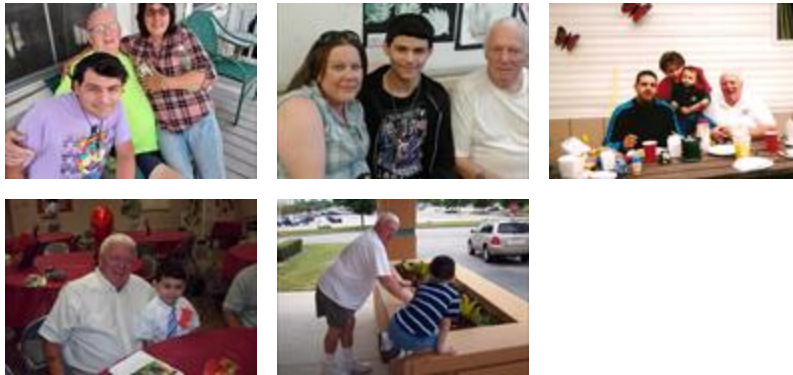

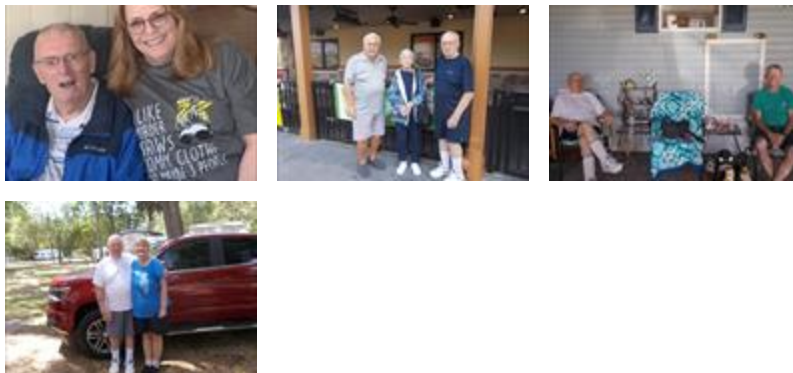
