Richard J. Wozniak of Mount Laurel died Friday October 2nd, 2009 at the Lutheran Home in Moorestown. He was 87. Mr. Wozniak was born in Philadelphia and was a graduate of Temple University. He served in the Army Air Corps in World War II with the 9th Bomber Division and received the Distinguished Flying Cross with 8 Oak Leaf Clusters and was also awarded the Purple Heart. After returning from the War he served as a chemist with various companies in the Delaware Valley. He was long active with the Knights of Columbus and the St. Vincent DePaul Society.

Mr. Wozniak is survived by his wife, Joan; four children: Jan Manger of Mount Holly, Richard Wozniak of Randolph, NJ, Faith Wozniak of Montclair, NJ and Anne Claire Madara of Solebury, PA. He is also survived by six grandchildren: Zachary, Melissa, Shanna, Josh, Paul and Emily Anne, by a brother Robert of Tansboro, NJ and by many nieces and nephews.
