



Robert L Applegate Sr.

March 18, 1924 - January 20, 2016

Robert L. Applegate, Sr. of Clementon, formerly of Mount Holly, passed away on Wednesday, January 20, 2016 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly. He was 91.

Born in Medford, and a graduate of Pemberton High School, Mr. Applegate was a US Navy Veteran of WW II & Korea. He was a retired letter carrier for the US Postal Service in Mount Holly and delivered flowers for Amy's Flower Junction for many years. He also was a bartender at Buzz's and the Woodshed and had worked at Garden State Race Track. Mr. Applegate played baseball and softball locally and traveled the world. He was a member of the VFW 2692, Mount Holly and the Mount Holly Moose. Mr. Applegate enjoyed going to the casinos but especially loved spending time with his family.

The husband of the late Ethel, and the father of the late Gail, he is survived by 4 children: Robert L. (Barbara) Applegate, Jr. of St. Augustine, FL; Karen J. (Bill) DiGiacomo of Westampton; Deena R. (Tom) Connelly of Clementon; and Lori (Bobby) Lyons of Mount Holly. The grandfather of 10 grandchildren, 23 great-grandchildren and 8 great-great grandchildren, he was predeceased by 4 sisters and 1 brother and is survived by 3 sisters and brothers-in-law as well as many nieces and nephews.
