Robert Z. Beavin of Southampton passed away on Monday, September 14, 2015 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 76.

Born in San Pedro, CA, Mr. Beavin was a longtime area resident. He was a retired Sgt in the US Army having served during Vietnam. He was a dedicated to serving his country and has a flag flown in his honor over the NJ Capitol building.
