June 1, 1943 - September 17, 2016

Robert F. Kelly, "Bob" of Southampton passed away on Saturday, September 17, 2016 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 73.

Born, June 1, 1943 in the Fairview Section of Camden to Philip J. and Anne (Boyle) Kelly, he later moved to Medford. Bob was in the first graduating class of Holy Cross High School in Delran, NJ, he then began a career as an electrician for IBEW Local 439 (later 351). He held the position of Treasurer for IBEW 439/351 until his retirement in 1998. Bob moved to Lumberton in 1979 and after his retirement settled in Leisuretown Southampton where he was famous for his Christmas decorations.
