February 17, 1944 - April 24, 2014

Robert Joseph Brownlee of Country Lakes in Browns Mills, NJ passed away Thursday, April 24, 2014 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly of Natural Causes. He was 70.

Born in Hammonton, New Jersey, Mr. Brownlee was the son of the late Clarence and Alice Brownlee. He was a retired Army Aviator and Vietnam Veteran. During his honorable service to our country he was awarded the Silver Star, Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart and Air Medal. Mr. Brownlee was also retired from the State of New Jersey Department of Health. He enjoyed fishing and vacations with his wife.

He is survived by his wife Lynn Brownlee of Country Lakes; son LTC Jeff Brownlee of Shamong, NJ; daughter and son-in-law Donna & Larry Heron of Hainesport; 5 grandchildren: Shelby Brownlee of Hainesport, NJ, Eric & Evan Brownlee of Cape Cod, MA; Kayla & Kelsey Heron of Hainesport, NJ. He is also survived by 5 siblings: Clarence (Skippy) Brownlee of WV; James Brownlee of West Trenton, NJ; Ralph Brownlee of Mays Landing, NJ; Cheryl Brownlee of Cape May, NJ, and Ronald Brownlee of Vineland, NJ.

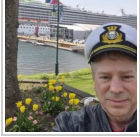
