Robert K. Cahall, Jr. of Browns Mills passed away on Sunday, December 27, 2015 at Cooper Hospital in Camden. He was 60.

Born in Mount Holly, Rob was a lifelong area resident. He was a 1974 graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School where he played football, basketball, and baseball. He attended Atlantic Community College and played baseball. While playing baseball in College, he was named a Junior College All-American and drafted as a pitcher by the New York Yankees. Rob was also a member of the RV Athletic Hall of Fame. He worked for Hercules and later for Sybron Chemical. He was an avid Phillies and Eagles fan, but his greatest love was his family.

The father of the late Ryan and the brother of the late Michael, he is survived by his wife, Theo, of Browns Mills; his son Robert Cahall, III of Mount Holly; 3 grandchildren, Sophia, David and Aiden; his parents, Betty Lou and Robert Cahall, Sr. of Mount Laurel; his brother, Peter Cahall; his mother-in-law, Janina Hopkins; father-in-law Philip Lancaster and stepmother-in-law, Sally Bree; brother-in-law, Christopher Lancaster; numerous aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, friends and many honorary family members, including Crystal Perry and her daughter, Autumn, Mary Dolan and Kelsey Gordon.
