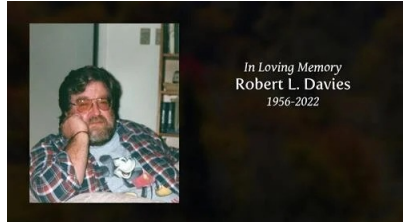

We will miss Bob. We will really miss our friend. Beth, Brian and Alison...There are no words to express our heartfelt feeling over your loss.

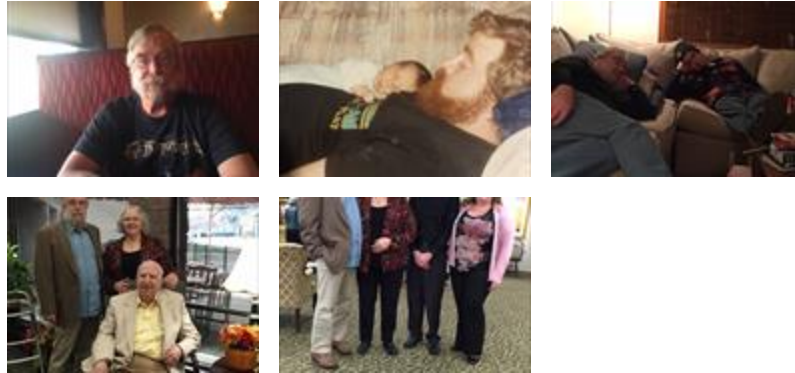

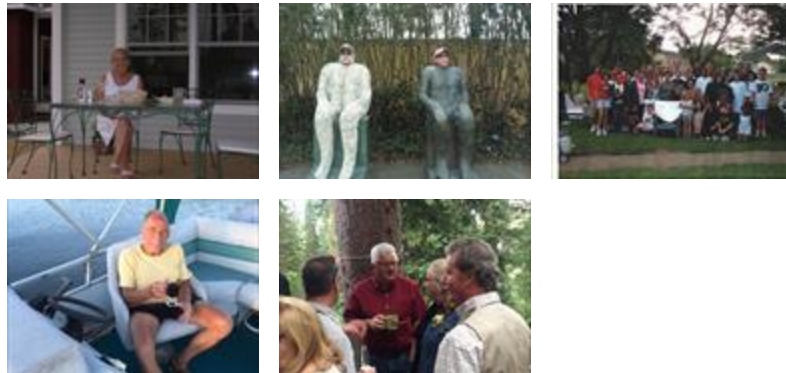

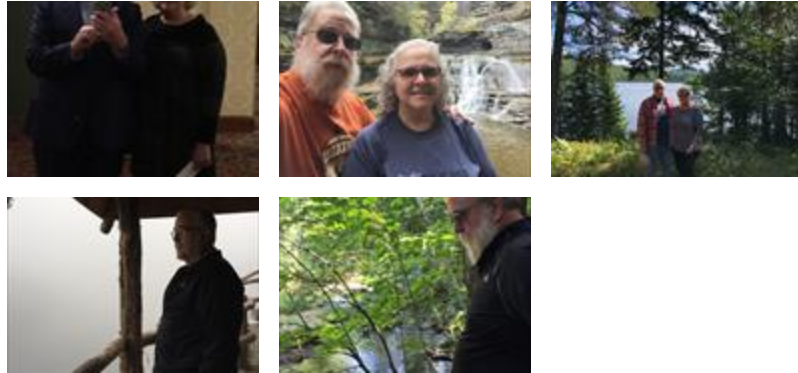
