Robert J. Moore, age 92, of Vincentown, passed away peacefully on Friday, February 24th at his home with his family by his side.

Born in Vincentown, Robert was a life-long resident and was the son of the late Alexander and Mary Moore. He served his country in the U.S. Army. Robert received his Bachelor's Degree from The King's College in Delaware and his Master's Degree from Rutgers University and completed several additional courses at Temple University. During high school and summers between college years, Robert worked at the Francis C. Stokes Company, Vincentown, and during college, worked at Farnsworth Hospital, Delaware. He began his career in education by teaching 8th grade in Vincentown and Pemberton Township School District. Robert served as a guidance counselor for many years at Pemberton Township High School and moved into administration, retiring as Superintendent of Schools.

Robert has been a lifetime member of the First Baptist Church of Vincentown serving as a deacon and several other positions at the church. He was a past member of the Board of Trustees of the Sally Stretch Keen Memorial Library. Robert also served for 38 years on the Southampton Township Committee. He was pre-deceased by his four brothers; George, Joseph, William, and Henry Moore.

Robert is survived by his wife of 68 years, Edna Moore, his children; Edward (Patricia) Moore, Susan (John) Wagner, and Barbara Moore; five grandsons; Robert Wagner, Christopher Wagner, Mark Wagner, Harry Moore, and

Timothy Moore; and a great-granddaughter, Margaret Wagner. He is also survived by several nieces and nephews.
