Robert C. Severs, Jr., age 72, of Tabernacle, passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday, April 27, 2025.

Born in Mount Holly, Rob grew up and lived in the “Bozuretown” section of Tabernacle all of his life. At the age of 5, he began working and driving tractors at the Severs family farm that specialized in blueberries and asparagus.

When he was just a sophomore at Lenape High School, his father opened the Severs Garage in 1968. Rob was a star basketball player at Lenape and turned down several offers of scholarships to play college basketball. He graduated in 1970 from Lenape High School and went to work in the family garage business started by his father where he worked until the time of his passing. Rob was an avid softball player all of his life.

One of his favorite activities was watching horse racing. He enjoyed it for many years.

Rob was pre-deceased by his father, Robert Severs, Sr. in 2008.

He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Linda (Dunfee) Severs, his son, Josh Severs and his wife, Falon, a grand-daughter, Blake “Blakey Girl” Severs, his mother, Rachel Severs, his aunts, Betty Carpenter, and Fay Eckman and numerous cousins.

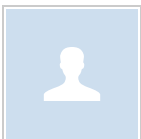
