Robert J. Vidinha of Bordentown, formerly of Eastampton, passed away on Wednesday, October 17, 2019 at Compassionate Care Hospice in Hamilton. He was 87.

Born in Koloa, Kauai, Hawaii, Mr. Vidinha served in the United States Air Force for over 30 years, retiring as a Chief Master Sergeant. After his retirement, he worked in Civil Service in Transportation Management for the Air Force. He was also a member of the Knights of Columbus on McGuire AFB.
