

## Robert "Bob" Pacitti

March 12, 1939 - January 6, 2014

Robert F. Pacitti "Bob", of Mount Laurel, a longtime Vincentown resident, died Monday, January 6, 2014 at Virtua Voorhees following a brief illness. He was 74.

Born in Mount Holly, he was known as "Bob the Barber" and had a barber shop in Pemberton, drove a truck for North Penn for many years, then opened the Towne Barber Shop in Vincentown.

Bob loved golfing, trap shooting, and riding his bike through the Pine Barrens. He also enjoyed wood carving. He was a member of the Junior Order of United America Mechanics of NJ – Vincentown Chapter and was a member of the Buddtown Methodist Church. Bob especially loved to attend his grandchildren's sporting events: football, soccer, track, and softball. He loved to spend time on the beach in LBI, Virginia Beach, and winter in Myrtle Beach.

He was truly loved and will be dearly missed by all who knew him.

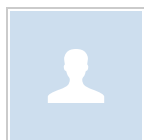

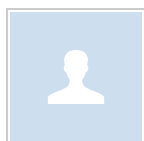
