



## Robert "Bob" Townsend

Robert "Bob" Townsend passed away peacefully in his home on Monday, December 30, 2013 after a brave battle with cancer. He was 78.

Bob lived in Columbus his whole life, working at the family business, Stevenson Lumber, for over 45 years before his retirement in 1999. He was also past President of Roebbling Savings and Loan.

His interests included woodworking in his shop, watching the Phillies and Eagles, and the occasional striper fishing trip. Bob especially enjoyed spending summers on Long Beach Island with his family watching the sunsets over the bay. He also liked the fresh crab feast cooked up Sunday afternoons on the deck.
