November 4, 1954 - February 20, 2013

Robert (Bob) Edward Lamont, 58, passed away suddenly of lung cancer on Wednesday, February 20, 2013 at Cooper University Hospital in Camden. Born November 4, 1954, in Trenton, Bob was the grateful recipient of a life saving liver transplant in 1999. He worked at the Philadelphia Sign Co. in Pennsauken and lived in Lumberton for the past sixteen years.

An avid Phillies, Eagles, and Flyers fan, he is survived by his loving wife, Maryanne Thompson; his brothers, Richard and David Lamont; predeceased by his brother Wayne Lamont; Bob is also survived by his three brothers-in-law; eight sisters-in-law; nine nephews; seven nieces; four great-nephews; and eight great-nieces.
