Dr. Robert H. Brown of Southampton passed away on Tuesday, July 26, 2011 at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mt. Holly. He was 73. An Air Force Veteran of Vietnam; Dr. Brown operated his own practice in Orthopedic Surgery in Elmer, NJ for many years. He was also a member of the Central Lodge #44 of F&AM in Vincentown, an officer for Lenape Farms Inc., and volunteered on the Battleship NJ. Dr. Brown was an avid gardener and hunter who loved to travel and spend time with his family.

He is survived by his loving wife Beverly (nee Anderson) of over 48 years; two daughters, Joanne Welther (Fred), Kristin Carroll (Sean); three grandchildren, Freddie Welther, Megan Welther, Moira Carroll; a brother, John C. Brown M.D. (Kay); and several nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
