



## Rodney A Sager Sr

Rodney A. Sager, Sr. of Southampton passed away on Thursday, March 16, 2017 at his home, surrounded by his family. He was 87.

Born in Ellisdale, NJ, Mr. Sager was a longtime area resident. He grew up in Mount Holly and was a member of the class of 1949 from Mount Holly High School. He served his country in the US Marine Corps and was a self-employed plumber. He also worked in the NJ Forest Fire Service as District Warden on B16. Rodney was a member of Central Lodge #44 F & AM, a member of Fellowship Alliance Chapel in Medford, was an avid hunter and fisherman, he played baseball for the Vincentown Merchants and was a faithful baseball fan.
