Roland S. Johnson, of Burlington Township, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, December 13, 2016 at the Masonic Home of Burlington Twp. He was 94. He was born in Mount Holly to the late William and Ethel Johnson. He was married to the late Evelyn.

Roland served in the US Army during World War II. He retired as a Vice President from the Midlantic Bank in Mount Holly.
