Rose Celita Bien-Aimé, a woman of profound faith, elegance, and boundless generosity, passed away peacefully in her sleep on Sunday, March 22, 2026. Born on November 17, 1936, in Petite Rivière de l'Artibonite, Haiti, Celita was raised in a vibrant household of 18 children—a beginning that shaped her lifelong commitment to family and community.

A savvy businesswoman with a "golden heart," Celita's success was measured not by what she kept, but by what she gave. She was known for her inability to witness hunger without taking action; her business served as a sanctuary that fed countless neighbors and friends.

A devout Christian, Celita's presence at church was as striking as her spirit. Always "dressed to the T," her impeccable style earned her the affectionate nickname "Demoiselle." She is survived by nine siblings and five children: Renette Louis, Rosemond Jean, Thania Jean, Lemond Jean, and Simone Jean. Her legacy lives on through her 22 grandchildren and a vast network of cousins, nieces and nephews. While she joins her four children who preceded her in rest, she will be forever missed by her immediate family and her beloved Restoration Church community.
