LeRoy "Roy" P. Ridgway, Jr. Mount Holly passed away on Tuesday, October 20, 2015 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly. He was 85.

Born in Pemberton, Mr. Ridgway was a lifelong area resident. He was a graduate of Pemberton High School and from Trenton State College and served as a fighter pilot in the US Navy. Mr. Ridgway was a longtime Physical Education Teacher, Coach, and later a Guidance Counselor at Rancocas Valley Regional High School in Mount Holly. He also was an avid golfer and former member at Burlington Country Club, a member of Pemberton's First Baptist Church, the Pemberton Masonic Lodge, and the Pemberton American Legion.
