



Roysten "Roy" Glenn

October 8, 1919 - February 16, 2013

Roysten "Roy" Glenn of Vincentown died Saturday, February 16, 2013 at his home. He was 93.

Born in Pennsauken, NJ, Mr. Glenn was a longtime Vincentown resident. He was US Army Veteran of WWII where he served under General Patton in the 3rd Army Division. He later worked as a Carpenter and Locksmith for New Lisbon and the Yardville Prison. Roy was a past member of the Southampton Township Board of Education and the Metamorphosis of the Prison System. He also enjoyed drag racing with his son.

The father of the late Joseph, Mr. Glenn is survived by his wife of 68 years, Betty; 2 sons and their spouses: Roy E. and Sandy Glenn of Vincentown, James Russell and Cindy Glenn of Tabernacle; and a daughter and her husband: Denise Kathleen and Edward Marion of Vincentown; 9 Grandchildren and 8 Great-grandchildren. Roy was predeceased by 12 brothers and sisters and is survived by a brother Gerald Glenn of South Carolina.
