Russell L. Gray, of Pemberton, passed away at his home on May 5th. He was 88 years old.

Son of the late Caleb and Blanche Gray, Russell was born on June 21, 1933 in Wrightstown, NJ, and lived in Columbus as a young child. The family eventually moved to a farm on Jacksonville Road, in Mount Holly. Russell attended Rancocas Valley high school where he graduated in 1951. After high school Russell enlisted in the US Navy and proudly served his country during the Korean War. Russell was a hardworking man and once he was discharged from the Navy he worked as a civil engineer for McGuire Airforce Base and on his family farm where he grew blueberries and greenhouse tomatoes. Russell was a past Master of the Pemberton Masonic Lodge, and he also collected vintage John Deere tractors with his wife. Russell will be remembered as a great husband, awesome father, grandfather and great-grandfather. He will be dearly missed.
