Salvatore A. Varsaci of Edgewater Park died Tuesday, March 13, 2012, at his residence. He was 79.

Born in Beverly, Mr. Varsaci was a lifelong farmer on the family farm in Edgewater Park. He was a member of the New Jersey Vegetable Growers Association.
