Samuel Scelza Jr., of Columbus passed away Sunday, February 7, 2010 at the age of 72. Born in Mt. Holly, Sam grew up in Pemberton, and was a 43-year resident of Columbus. Sam was a Marine Corps Veteran and a lifetime member of the Marine Corps League. He actively supported the Marine Corps – Law Enforcement Foundation. Sam founded Scelza Construction Company, LLC in 1958, which he continued until his death. He was a former member of the Mansfield Township Zoning Board and Board of Education. He was a devoted husband, father and grandfather, and a member of St. Andrews Catholic Church in Jobstown.
