Sandra B. Fowler (Finsen) of Westampton passed away Friday, February 14, 2014 at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania. She was 46.

Born in Germany, Sandy grew up in Eastampton and was a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School. She earned her Associates Degree from Burlington County College and worked for many years at Carlson Craft/Celebration in Lumberton. Most recently she worked in Medical Billing for Farnsworth & Semptimphelter.

Sandy is survived by her parents Gerald E. and Helga F.
