Stephan Wolfrom passed away suddenly on October 30, 2016 at his home. He was 63. Born in Mount Holly, he was a longtime Lumberton resident.

Stephan Wolfrom meant so much to so many people. To some, he was a friend and colleague, to others, a benefactor whose generosity was a lifeline in times of need. Beyond his own family, he was a father figure and friend; a teacher, guiding voice and inspiration to everyone who got to know him. His energy seemed as limitless as his knowledge; he was a man who would climb up onto the roof of a house to fix a leak, and while up there, tell you the names of the surrounding trees (in Latin). For his children, he was a role model in so many ways, and while we are shocked that his time on earth has ended, we know that he would not want his loss to become a void, the example of his life lost in grief. 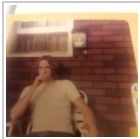
