Tara N. Wolozyn of Shamong, passed away on Monday, February 6, 2023 at her home. She was 50. Born in Big Spring, Texas, she was the daughter of Joseph R. Wolozyn (USAF) and the late Cheryl E. Wolozyn. For much of her childhood, her father was serving in the Air Force so they lived in Texas, Alabama, Delaware, and New Jersey, where she graduated from Rancocas Valley Regional High School. Tara went on to earn her Bachelors Degree in Social Work from Millersville University and her Master's Degree from Rutgers University. She worked in social work, including child counseling at various hospitals including Virtua, Deborah and Jefferson, and also worked for the State of New Jersey in the Social Crisis Intervention Program "SCIP."

Tara enjoyed artwork, and spending time reading. She loved gardening and flowers and enjoyed spending time with family and friends. Her nephew Cole, said "Tara was so fun." The happiest time of her life has been spent with her fiancé, Steve Tiver.

Tara was predeceased by her mother, Cheryl and is survived by her father Joseph Richard Wolozyn; her grandmother Evelyn Elizabeth McLaughlin; brother David Wolozyn and his wife Kim; nephew Cole; and several cousins, as well as other family and many friends.
