Teresa Gallagher D'Entremont, "Terri," a lifelong resident of Mount Holly, NJ, went to be with the Lord, on Thursday, July 1, 2021. She was 72.

Born July 17, 1948 in Greenville, NC, to her late parents, Joseph and Jane Rogers Gallagher, Terri was a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School of Mount Holly and attended Chowan College in Murfreesboro, NC. 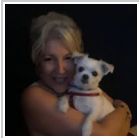
