Theresa Lynn Diamond of Philadelphia, a former resident of Lumberton, passed away suddenly on June 13, 2024, at Temple Hospital. She was 51. Born in Trenton, Theresa was a longtime area resident. She grew up in Lumberton, graduated from Rancocas Valley Regional High School in 1991, and later attended Drexel University, where she pursued a degree in psychology.

Theresa had many hobbies and interests, such as watching movies, listening to diverse types of music, meditating, riding her Peloton, cooking, and spending time outdoors laying out in the sun by the water. She was fierce, determined, and strong-willed and had an incredible love for life. But most important to her was the love for her children and grandchildren. The daughter of the late Delbert Borden, Sr, Theresa leaves behind her five children: Alexandra Henwood (Bolivar), Darryn Henwood (Cynthia), Deanah

Elizabeth Henwood, Julian Diamond, and Mayah Diamond; four grandchildren: Jadyn, Michael, Zariella, and King John "KJ."
