



## Thomas Dempster

June 28, 1934 - December 29, 2015

Thomas Dempster of Burlington Township, a longtime Delaware Valley resident, passed away on Tuesday, December 29, 2015 at Aria Torresdale Frankford Hospital. He was 81.
