Thomas DiVincenzo of Mount Laurel passed away on Monday, November 21, 2016 at his home. He was 69.

Born April 11, 1947 in Camden, Thomas was the only child of Gaetano and Frances DiVincenzo. He had a lifetime passion for military history and weapons technology. He was a Black Belt in Tae Kwon Do who enjoyed painting, photography, chess, folk and doo-wop music, and cooking great pasta.

Tom was a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep and earned a Business Degree from Villanova University, where he became a lifetime Wildcats fan, never missing a game over the years. He was thrilled when they won the championship in 1985, and ecstatic at their last-second victory again this year. Also a lifetime Philadelphia Eagles fan, he held out hope every season that they would win the Super Bowl, and he could be heard yelling at the tv in the next room when it inevitably didn't work out.

Tom worked in education and the medical insurance industry in Philadelphia, and later in manufacturing in South Jersey.

Thomas is survived by his son Stephan DiVincenzo of Mount Holly; daughter Andrea Yannella of Park Ridge, IL; and grandchildren Joseph Yannella and Ava Yannella.
