Thomas R. Haff passed away on Friday, September 27, 2013 at the Evergreens Retirement Home in Moorestown. He was 89 years old.

The son of the late Philip and Margaret Haff, Tom was born in Minneapolis, Minnesota and moved over 15 times in his childhood ending in Baltimore, MD where he graduated from Baltimore Polytechnic Institute. During WW II he served as a Single Engine Pilot, training future fighter pilots. Upon his discharge, he entered and graduated from Johns Hopkins University.

In 1946 he married Gertrude Sperlein, who passed away in 2007, with whom he had two daughters, Janice DeJianne (husband Joseph) of Hainesport and Jane Fish of Mount Laurel. He spent over 33 years in telecommunications, his last 20 years with AT&T in the NY area. He and his wife lived 45 years in Chatham, NJ. Tom was an avid golfer throughout his life. He had two holes-in-one and could shoot his age throughout his 80s.

In addition to his daughters, he is also survived by 5 grandchildren, Matthew (Tracey), Sara, Laura (Saul), Ryan (Kristen), and Jenna; and 1 great-grandson, Andrew. The brother of the late Rosemary Townsend, he is also survived by a son-in-law Joseph Fish and his loving friend Eleanor Stevenson of the Evergreens.
