



## Timothy Barto

November 17, 1955 - June 8, 2012

Timothy James Barto of Hainesport died Saturday, June 9, 2012 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit at Virtua Memorial Hospital in Mount Holly. He was 56.

Tim was born in Mount Holly and was a 1973 graduate of Rancocas Valley High School.

A lifelong resident of Hainesport, he was a mechanic and worked for Equipment Depot in Cherry Hill. He was shop steward for Local #542 of the International Operating Engineers and he was the chief mechanic for his son, Quinton's Quad Racing Team. Mr. Barto was a Past Champion of the Eastern Mud Racing Association.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Loretta "Cookie," and his father, James.
