She was 51. Born in Mount Holly, Tracy attended Sacred Heart School and graduated from Rancocas Valley Reg. High School in the class of '84. Tracy was dedicated for many years to her job as a construction project coordinator, where countless friendships she made while working in the field became some of her deepest, long-lasting relationships.

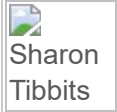
