T. Ronald Gsell, PE, LS, PP, of Brigantine, N.J., formerly of Mount Holly, died Friday, Nov. 25, 2011, at the Mainland division of Atlantic City Medical Center in Pomona. He was 80.

Mr. Gsell was born in Riverside, the son of the late Harry and Kathryn White Gsell.

He was a 1949 graduate of Mount Holly High School.

Mr. Gsell was employed by A.C. Jones Engineers in Mount Holly, and then by Alaimo Associates Civil Engineers for more than 30 years. He was a professional engineer, a licensed surveyor and a professional planner. Mr. Gsell was the township engineer for many communities in South Jersey, most notably for Evesham Township and Eastampton Township.

He was a member of Mount Holly Lodge 848 BPOE, and later the Brigantine Elks Lodge.

Mr. Gsell is survived by his wife Margaret "Peggy"; two sons, Thomas (Dorie) of Los Angeles, Calif., Mark Ronald Gsell of Rohnert Park, Calif., and a daughter, Toni Gsell of Mission Viejo, Calif. He also is survived by two stepchildren, Leslie F. Lamb (Marlene) of Middleton, Wis., and Lynn Grancell (Michael) of Lumberton; and 10 grandchildren, Jon, Sarah, Josh, Stephen, Erica, Parker, Kameron, Jennifer, Luke and Sierra.

There will be a memorial service at 11 a.m. Thursday, Dec. 1, at Perinchief Chapels, 438 High St., Mount Holly, where friends are invited to visit with the family from 10 to 11 a.m. Interment will be held privately.
