Veronica Brennan, “Ronnie” passed away on Thursday, August 12, 2021 at Marcella Rehab Center in Burlington Township surrounded by loved ones. She was 76.

Born in Philadelphia, Ronnie was a lifelong resident of Lumberton and a graduate of Rancocas Valley Regional High School. She was a homemaker in addition to working for Sears Surplus, a matron and crossing guard for the Lumberton Police and a Class 2 Special Officer for Mount Holly Police.
