I was 21. She still made sure to take care of her own AND the patients.

In 2021 I celebrated 10 years of volunteering with her.

I haven't done anything since I moved out/away but we'd always keep in touch. Especially via fb and sharing pictures of the kids//grand (her kids were my age + haha)

She will be truly missed. My heart goes out to everyone that loved her and she loved.

Thanks for being my birthday buddy (or allowing me to rain on your bday parade 30 years later haha) and all the times you've helped me by listening to my never ended Jerry Springer saga I call LIFE and for always being there to help with school, hours, and references.

Thank you Vicky for showing me there are people in the world that care for others as much, or more, than themselves, no matter how scary, dark, and cold the world can be.

I'll raise a toast in 97 days to us 💖

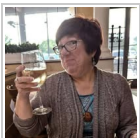
