Vincent Benedetti, Jr. of Burlington Township, passed away on Friday, January 23, 2015 at the Samaritan Hospice Inpatient Unit in Mount Holly. He was 46.

Born in Trenton and a graduate of McCorriston High School and Rowan University, Mr. Benedetti worked as Portfolio Manager for the State of New Jersey. He was a member and secretary of the Chambersburg Hunting Club and enjoyed coaching his son's baseball teams in Burlington Township. Vincent was a lifelong NY Yankees' fan with a big personality and generous heart.

The son of the late Vincent, Sr., he is survived by his wife of 17 years, Lisa; 2 children Isabella & Vincent, III; his mother Connie of Little Egg Harbor; his brother & sister-in-law: Gino & Theresa Benedetti of Media, PA; a sister-in-law: Christine & her husband Tommy as well as 5 nieces and nephews: Vincent, Maria, Gino, Helen, & Xavier.
