



## Vincent W Ferraiuolo

Vincent W. Ferraiuolo, known lovingly as “Vinny” to his friends and family, passed away on February 14, 2026, at the age of 63.

Born on July 20, 1962, in Hoboken, New Jersey, Vinny was proud of his roots and the community that shaped him.
