



## Vincent V. Giansanti

November 30, 1931 - October 10, 2017

Vincent V. Giansanti, of Barnsboro, passed away on Tuesday, October 10, 2017 at his home surrounded by his family. He was 85. He was born on November 30, 1931 to Albert and Frances Giansanti in Camden, NJ.

He attended Camden High and graduated in 1949. Vincent was very active in sports and played basketball for Camden High School which he helped lead the team to their first state championship. He was active with Mt. Holly CYO where he served as head coach and president. He was also involved with the Sacred Heart basketball programs. He served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War. After his service, he worked as a Supervisory Equipment Specialist A/AE for the Department of the Navy.

He is predeceased by his parents; his daughter, Sharon; his daughter-in-law, Margaret; his sisters, Catherine and Anna; and his brother, George.

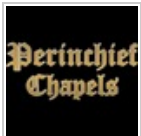
