Vincent L. Sutera, age 52, lost his struggle with pancreatic cancer on August 26th , 2016. Vince was born in Elizabeth, NJ to his surviving parents, Vincent T. and Jean Sutera. They raised him in Roselle and then Edison. He graduated college from Rutgers University and lived in Burlington Township for the last 14 years. He worked in sales, especially related to technology, for most of his career. He was very dedicated and loved his work, most recently for Advantage Communications.

He was also a member of the Board of Governors for the Y of Mount Laurel where he met many more wonderful friends. They were all very important to him and were so supportive throughout his illness.
