Virginia Rose Gambino of Mt. Holly passed away peacefully at Buttonwood Hospital on Wednesday, April 18. She was 86.

Born in Pittsburgh, Virginia was one of nine children and is survived by three brothers: John, James, and Robert Kearney and many nieces and nephews all in the Pittsburgh area.

A resident of Mt. Holly for over 35 years, Virginia enjoyed homemaking, reading and social evenings with friends, and playing Bingo and cards. She also was an active volunteer supporting the Sacred Heart Bingo kitchen. As a charter member of The St Vincent dePaul Society conference of Sacred Heart Parish, Virginia worked tirelessly for more than ten years serving God by helping the poor and needy of the community.

A life change in her early '50's gave Virginia the opportunity to learn to drive, return to school, and graduate. Earning her LPN license, she worked for five years at Evergreen Psychiatric Hospital. She was most proud of these accomplishments, as was her family.
