Vivian Guest died peacefully at her home in Mount Laurel, NJ on April 27th, 2009, 33 days short of her 90th birthday from complications of Alzheimer's disease. Born in Newfield, NJ on May 30th, 1919, the only daughter of Milton S. Edwards, Sr. and Alma Warner Edwards, in later life she became known to all as Nana. She was the wife of the late Edmund J. Guest, Jr. who died in 1975. Nana was the consummate mother, grandmother and dedicated Christian who was beloved for her quick and engaging smile. Her family, her home and her church were the anchors of her life. Wherever she lived during her long life, she always sought out the local Methodist Church and volunteered for the choir and other activities. Her great joy was having her family around her and setting an overloaded table for them. She looked forward to Thanksgiving every year.

Mrs. Guest had several jobs during her working career; including assisting in the Library at Rancocas Valley Regional High School and many years as an administrative assistant at General Adjustment Bureau (GAB) in Philadelphia. She retired in the early 1980's.

Vivian is survived by two sons; Edmund and his wife Karen of East Burke, VT, and Brian and his wife Lynda of Mount Laurel, NJ as well as five grandchildren: Shelly Cermak, Kristen Kaspro, Derylyn J. Stokes, E. James Guest IV and Michelle Grimes and 12 great grandchildren. She was the sister of the late Milton Edwards and is survived by a sister-in-law Olene of Newfield, NJ.
