



Vivian Henry Howarth

December 8, 1917 - April 10, 2011

Vivian Henry Howarth of Moorestown passed away at Harmony Village, Care One on Sunday, April 10, 2011. She was 93. Prior to her recent move to Harmony Village, she had lived at the Evergreens Continuing Care in Moorestown for 10 years.

She is survived by her loving family, daughter Anne H. Redlus (Howard) and son Alan C. Howarth (Susan); her grandchildren, Mark Redlus, Leigh Redlus, Eric Redlus (Rachel), Katherine Howarth, Kristen Howarth and great-granddaughter, Katherine Redlus.

Vivian was preceded in death by her husband of 67 years, Myrton, her parents Marion C. and Anne Olsen Henry, and her sister, Ruth H. Hunt.

Born in Plainfield, NJ, Vivian graduated from Plainfield High School (1934) and New Jersey College for Women (Douglass College), Class of 1938 where she majored in music. She resided in Plainfield until 1977 when they moved to Mt. Laurel. During the years in Plainfield, Vivian taught private piano lessons in her home and was a long term substitute in the Plainfield and South Plainfield School Systems. She taught 5th grade at the John E. Riley School in South Plainfield for 10 years prior to their move. Vivian also was a member of the Monday Afternoon Club in Plainfield and a volunteer with the Hospital Auxiliary, Muhlenberg Hospital. Vivian loved her times at their summer home

on Long Beach Island since 1980.

Funeral Services will be held at Perinchief Chapels, 438 High Street, Mt. Holly at 10:30 AM on Wednesday, April 13 with visitation with the family from 9:30-10:30 AM. Interment is in Fairview Cemetery, Westfield, NJ.
