Warren H Johnson a lifelong resident of the Village of Rancocas died Thursday, August 22, 2013 at his home. He was 91.

Mr. Johnson was a 1941 Graduate of Rancocas Valley Reg. High School, and served in the US Coast Guard during WWII on board the USS Tampa. Warren worked for PSE&G as an electrician until his retirement. He was an avid sportsman and a member of the Burlington County Fish and Game League. Warren was involved in the reintroduction of wild turkeys to New Jersey and enjoyed woodcarving waterfowl. He played in a band at the Columbus Farmers Market and Alberts Hall in Waretown. He enjoyed drawing the buildings and homes of Rancocas and local area history and was especially proud of his tomato garden.

The husband of the late Doris M, he is survived by his daughter Patricia (George) A. Smith of Hainesport and son Carter (Sandra) W. Johnson of Rancocas; 3 grandchildren: Jennifer (William IV) Toth, Heather (Brian) Gross, and Addison Johnson; and 3 great-grandchildren: Paige Toth, William Toth V, and Colette Gross.
