Wilfred J. Desroches of Browns Mills passed away Monday, February 6, 2012 at Our Lady of Lourdes Medical Center in Willingboro. He was 73. Born in New London, CT, he enlisted in the US Navy for four years and then re-enlisted in the US Army where he served two tours of duty in Vietnam, receiving a Bronze Star and retiring as a Staff Sergeant.

Wilfred was a member of the Browns Mills VFW Post #6085 and the American Legion. He loved animals, cars and the time he could share with his loving grandchildren.
